

## **Brake Recognises Life-Saving CG-Lock Device at Annual Fleet Safety Forum Awards**

The annual **Fleet Safety Forum Awards for Excellence**, sponsored by fleet management company ARVAL, was held on Thursday (25 June) at a prestigious gala dinner at the Chesford Grange Hotel in Warwickshire, with more than 250 guests in attendance.

The awards are run by the Fleet Safety Forum, a division of road safety charity Brake, to recognise the achievements of those working in the rapidly developing field of road risk management.
